

AOOS Executive Committee Meeting Summary draft March 1, 2019

Attending by phone: Katrina Hoffman (Chair), Jim Kendall (Treasurer), Cheryl Rosa (Secretary), Ed Page (Vice Chair) and Tara Riemer (ad hoc).

Chair Katrina Hoffman called the meeting to order at 1:03 pm.

At its November 2, 2018 meeting, the board directed staff to develop 2 options for spending those discretionary funds that would combine the biology data funding and filling the gaps observation funding, The Executive Committee met to consider the proposed options (attached).

Action: The Executive Committee discussed the options and voted unanimously (Motion by Kendall; second by Hoffman, with Ed Page abstaining due to a conflict of interest) to rank the options thusly: Funds for observing assets \$50K: 1) AIS/weather station on East Cape/St. Lawrence Island by MXAK; 2) ADCPS for Beaufort Sea projects; 3) Ice radar. Funds for biological data, \$15K: 1) COASTT program seabird dataset and 2) 30 years of Beaufort fish surveys. If for some reason the #1 priorities become unfeasible, then staff can go to the next item in ranking.
